PORTSEA HERITAGE

The Portsea represents our modern twist on the classic 'Marine Chronometer' timepiece style, which is traditionally characterised by clean white dials and arabic numerals.

With a multi-layered construction, the Portsea dial exhibits great depth that is further enhanced by the the use of a unique thick ceramic main disc.

The "Heritage" version of the Portsea is powered by the robust Seiko NH35 automatic movement and also features a surgical grade 316L stainless steel case, coin-stamped caseback and german leather straps.




OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Your Portsea Heritage timepiece is fitted with the Seiko Cal. NH35 automatic movement with the date at 6 the o'clock position.

The crown may be placed in 3 positions as per the image below.

- Fully pushed in when in this position, the crown can be rotated clockwise to manually wind the movement.
- Partially pulled out The middle crown position allows for the date to be adjusted by counterclockwise rotation.
- C. Fully pulled out when in this position, the crown can be rotated in both directions to set the time.



Notes:

- The date requires manual advancement for months with less than 31 days.
- Do not manually adjust the date during the automatic change-over action as this may damage the gearing in the mechanism.



WARRANTY INFORMATION

All watches purchased from Melbourne Watch Company come with a 24-month manufacturer's warranty.

This warranty covers material production defects concerning the watch, strap and movement.

It does not cover damage caused through misuse/physical force, or normal wear and tear.

Your warranty will be valid from the date of purchase and will be noted on a warranty card included with your order when shipped.

Your warranty will be rendered void if any attempts are made to repair or modify your timepiece without prior consent from us.
